




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THE LEGEND OF XI'AN

WALK THE PATH OF EMPEROR QIN SHIHUANG AND IMMERSE YOURSELF IN THE HISTORY AND CULTURE OF ANCIENT CHINA.

The Terracotta Warriors, the EPang Palace, the Mausoleum of the First Qin Emperor: nowhere represents the past glory of China as much as the historical city of Xi'an. Allow your children to embark on a journey in world-recognized museums and historical sites, listening to the on-site archaeologists explain the unsolved mysteries, working in groups with the local students for some thought-provoking discussions. Nothing better sparks the interest of learning another language and culture than a deep immersion into the country's stories and legends.



Who: Age 9-13. Minimum 3 years immersion or 4 years Chinese learning as a world language.

IMMERSE IN THE CHINESE CULTURE IN A 600-YEAR OLD HAKKA VILLAGE IN SOUTHEAST CHINA WHERE TIME SITS STILL!

DAILY PROGRAM

DAY 1	Camp opening. A basic training in design language.
DAY 2	The Chinese Footprint: join our artists to learn the traditional handcrafts designs such as vegetation dye and bamboo weaving.
DAY 3	Field Trip Day: the Forbidden City and its significance in architectural design.
DAY 4	Arrive in Peitian Village. Design Club Orientation - to build a dream playground for the local children.
DAY 5	Tongxing class: What is Design? Culture: to design a lantern of Peitian style. Tradition: What makes Peitian special?
DAY 6	Tongxing class: Get to know your clients. Interaction: What do the local children want for a playground? Culture: the paddy field and its habitants.
DAY 7	Tongxing Class: submit your first design. Interaction: villagers vote on the best design. Culture: the 100 way of playing with bamboo.
DAY 8	Tongxing Class: refine your design. Build the mockup.
DAY 9	It's Showtime! Invite the locals to attend the show, explain the design and get the vote. Congrats, future designers. You did it!
DAY 10	Departure.

Can parents accompany their children to these trips?

For the Beijing cultural prep sessions, parents are allowed to participate together with their children. For the following drama and design clubs, as well the entire Xi'an History and Culture Trip, children are encouraged to participate alone. Parents who wish to come along to Xi'an, Songhua Lake, or Peitian will be accommodated in a separate hotel from where the children are staying. Transportation and accommodation fee of the parents for these places are paid separately.

• What's the condition with the accommodation?

In Beijing and Xi'an, 3 or 4-star hotels will be arranged. In Songjiang Lake and Peitian, two children will be sharing a room in a local-brand hotel with standards of a 3-star hotel.
